

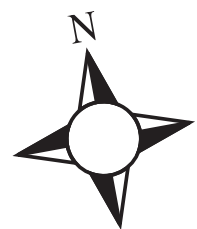

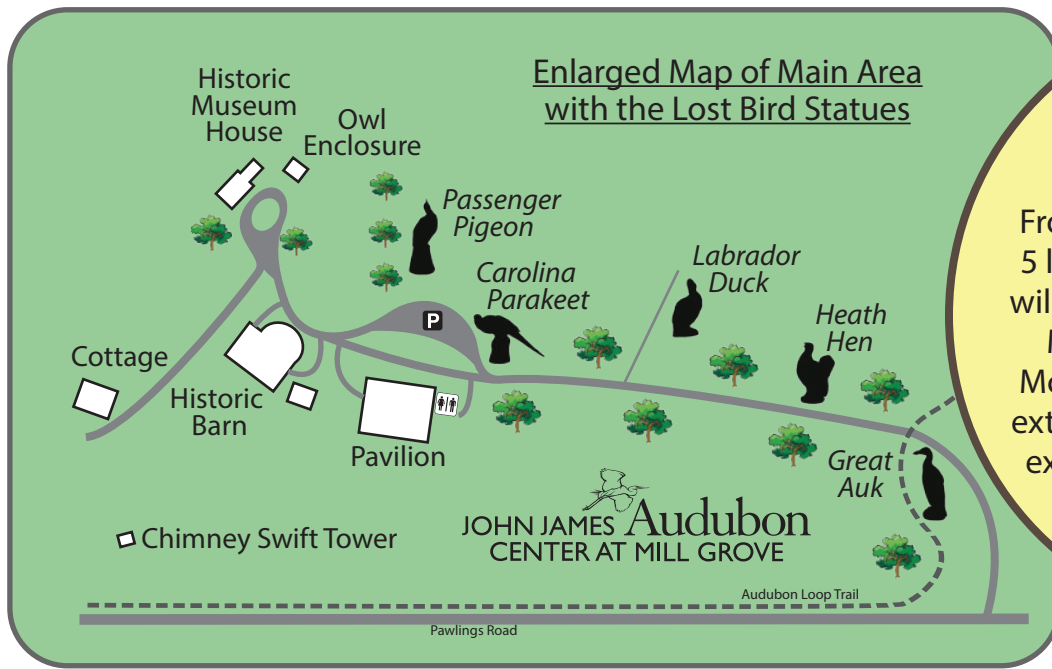
Main Entrance

Wooded, rocky with steep inclines
-  Wetherill Trail ~ .25 mile
Wooded, rocky trail with hill
-  Copper Mine Trail ~ 1 mile
Wooded, rocky trail with hill
-  Bird Habitat Trail ~ 1 mile
Open meadows, grassy trail
-  Audubon Loop Trail ~ 4.5 miles
