Museum Hours: Tuesday – Saturday 10 am – 4 pm
 Sunday 1 pm – 4 pm
 Monday, Major Holidays CLOSED

Grounds Hours: open daily, dawn to dusk

- Commercial Photographers: need a permit to photograph on Mill Grove Property. These permits can be purchased in the Museum Gift Shop.
- No PETS allowed
- Horseback riding, bikes, rollerblades, roller skates, or skateboards must keep to the paved Audubon Loop and are not permitted on the dirt Mill Grove trails.
- Feeding, disturbing or harassing any of the wildlife is prohibited.
- No alcoholic beverages, illegal drugs or controlled substances
- No fireworks, firearms, bow and arrows, sling shots, air guns, pellet guns or BB guns
- Littering is prohibited
- No person shall engage in unruly, indecent, boisterous or disorderly conduct
- Fires are prohibited.
- Parking motor vehicles in areas other than designated for parking is prohibited.
- The operation of motorized recreational vehicles including ATV's, snowmobiles, trail bikes, and mini-bikes is prohibited.
- Hunting and trapping are prohibited.
- Releasing or abandoning wild or domestic animals, non-native fish, or aquatic life is prohibited.
- Defacing, damaging or removing any property including any vegetation, rocks or minerals is prohibited.
- Fishing and boating are prohibited.
- Swimming is prohibited.
- Ice skating and ice fishing are prohibited.
- Overnight camping for the general public is prohibited.
- The use of metal detectors is prohibited.
- Posting signs, distributing, selling, servicing or renting any supplies, equipment, materials, or commodity or soliciting for any purpose without the written permission from the Parks Dept. or the Dept. of History and Cultural Arts is prohibited.
- Special events are permitted only if approval has been granted for a Special Use permit.
